WHAT TO DO DURING OCTOBER

Winter has past, hopefully, but summer's hot (25⁰/30⁰ C) days are here, what happened to Spring?

A bone of contention, I believe one should leave bonsai to flourish now, grow wild then cut back and clean up, thus allowing the root system to recover from the winter and the branches to soften, thicken up and new shots to form. Other enthusiasts say control regularly by cutting back and keep in form.

This is the time to use a high nitrogen content fertilizer to stimulate new growth and bring on flowering. We stock a "starter" quality granular fertilizer that is found to be very effective at the start of Spring. Specifications: 2.1.2 water soluble with all the micro elements plus cytokinins and auxins.

Thereafter use a high nitrogen content fertilizer, say a 3.1.6 or even a 6.1.3 depending on the species until January, then change to 3.1.6 high phosphorus & Potassium for root growth until end of April.
